### How to assemble the Fool Toy ( Read all instructions before cutting out paper toy.)

- A. Make the cuts on the hands and right foot with a sharp knife.
- B. Cut along the blue cutting lines with scissors or a sharp knife.
- C. Crease along all folding lines -----.
- D. Glue the head, body, legs and double faced parts separately.  
*Hint: use double sided tape instead of glue*
- E. Glue the the tips of the hat.
- F. Assemble all parts and glue together using the matching numbers on the body.
- G. Insert the mouse and roll of paper into the hands and the books into the right foot. Bend base if Fool is leaning over.

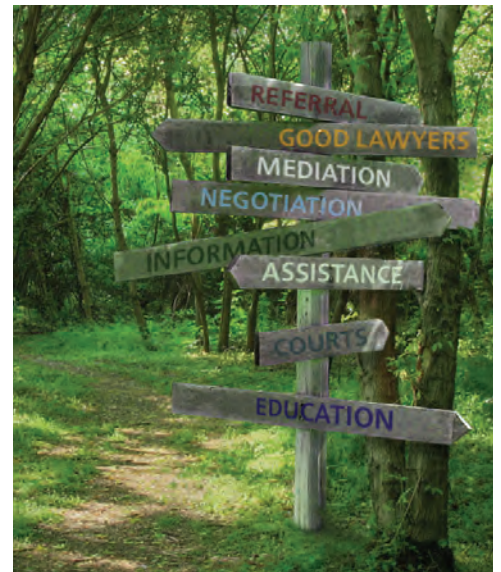
